# Membership Categories

<b>Youth Membership</b>	Ages 15 to 18 (Full Facility Membership)
<b>College Membership</b>	Full Time College Student (Must give copy of class schedule). Membership will expire after 4 months and can be reactivated by bringing copy of new semester schedule.
<b>Adult Membership</b>	Ages 19 to 61
<b>Family Membership</b>	The Pickens County YMCA considers a family unit as a husband and wife who are licensed as married under South Carolina law, all biological, adoptive, and foster children in the household ages 22 and under who are still living at home.
<b>Single Parent Membership</b>	Single parent and all biological, adoptive, and foster children in the Household ages 22 and under who are still living at home.
<b>Senior Membership</b>	Ages 62 and up
<b>Senior Couple Membership</b>	Ages 62 and up. Only 1 spouse in each couple need be age 62 or older for Senior Couple Membership.
<b>Upstate Adult Membership</b>	Ages 19-61, use of any one of the facilities in Pickens County, Anderson County, Greenville County, Spartanburg County, or Laurens County.
<b>Upstate Family Membership</b>	Pickens County Family Membership rules apply but have access to any one of the facilities in Pickens County, Anderson County, Greenville County, Spartanburg County, or Laurens County.

- Financial Assistance is available for those who qualify.
- Annual Memberships are Non-Refundable.
- Draft Options: Checking, Savings, Visa, MasterCard, or Discover.

**Bank Draft Option:** This is a convenient way to pay for your membership on a monthly basis. After paying the initiation fee, the monthly fee can be automatically debited from a credit card, checking account or savings account. Changes to accounts and cancellation require 5 days written notice to the YMCA.

**Yearly Membership:** Available for those who do not wish to have the monthly fee drafted. Yearly Memberships are Non-Refundable.

**Monthly over the counter payments at the facility are not accepted.**

## Military Outreach Initiative

We understand that military families are under enormous strain. As a member of the Y, you and your family can spend quality time together and enjoy fun activities in a warm, supportive environment. It's also a place to meet other military families who can relate to your unique situation. There is no charge for those who are eligible.

## Who is eligible for YMCA Military Membership?

Title 10 personnel are eligible for a Y membership, including:

- Family members of deployed National Guard and Reservists
- Active Duty Independent Duty personnel and their families
- Relocated spouse/dependent children of deployed Active Duty personnel

**Note:** The Relocated Spouse category supports families/spouse who relocate away from an installation/duty station while the active duty service member is deployed. All of the following criteria must be met:

- The service member is on active duty.
- The service member is DEPLOYED for a minimum of six months (on deployment orders—NOT unaccompanied orders, NOT geographic bachelors).
- The spouse has relocated away from the military installation where the service member is assigned (most often, back home near family).
- Wounded service members assigned to a Community Based Warrior in Transition Unit (CBWTU)

## Guest Policy

The Pickens County YMCA welcomes guests and visitors to try out our facilities up to 3 times per calendar year free of charge. There is a \$10.00 per day charge for each additional visit during the calendar year. All guests and visitors will be required to fill out a guest card and show a picture ID on their initial visit each calendar year. Free visits do not apply to the outdoor pool at Easley. There is a \$10.00 per day charge to use the outdoor pool.

## Age Policy

The YMCA does not allow unsupervised (i.e. drop off) use of facilities for children under the age of 14. Children ages 11-14 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian in the Wellness Center. Ages 15 & up have full facility use.
