

Summer Camp FAQ's Sheet

What is the cost for summer camp?

Registration Fee(s)	\$40.00/child (April 1 – April 30) \$60.00/child (May 1 or later)
Powersville	Members: \$110.00/week Non-Members: 130.00/week No drop in rates
Easley	Members: \$95.00/week Non-Members: \$115.00/week No drop in rates
Pickens	Members: \$90.00/week Non-Members: \$110/week No drop in rates

**2nd & 3rd child discounts are available (see website)

Will I be charged if my child does not attend?

You will not be charged for weeks that you did not select on the registration form.

If you selected a week and your child does not attend that week you will be charged a fee of \$50/week for members & \$70/week for non members. This applies to all the weeks registered for but not attended.

What do I need to do to register my child?

Parents will register online at www.psymca.net. The registration fee will draft at the time of registration.

When is my registration complete?

The registration process is complete when the registration fee has been drafted.

How do I apply for Financial Assistance?

Parents wishing to apply for Financial Assistance will have the opportunity to apply within the summer camp registration form.

What will my child do all day?

Campers participate in a wide variety of activities throughout the camp day. These include sports, games, arts and crafts, swimming (at least 4 days per week!), field trips (roughly once every other week depending on the age group), daily devotions, camper choice, Camp Songs & Skits and much more!

Will my child be going on field trips this summer?

Yes! Each age group will go on 4 field trips throughout the course of the summer. You can find a complete list of field trips on the camp calendar (coming soon!)

When will my child be swimming?

This will vary based on camp location & age groups. The Easley, Pickens & Powdersville camps swim at least 4 days each week.

What are the age groups for camp?

Due to varying camp sizes, age groups vary by camp site. Age group is determined by the child's rising grade.

When will my weekly camp fees be drafted?

Weekly camp fees will be drafted on the Tuesday following the week the child attends (i.e. June 10-14 will draft on Tuesday, June 18, 2019)

Is lunch provided?

Lunch options vary by camp site:

Easley & Pickens

Lunch is provided for most of the summer through a partnership with the Seamless Summer Feeding Program. These FREE lunches will be provided for our summer camp programs. In addition, Easley & Pickens will offer lunch options for purchase for \$5.00 per day, per child.

Powdersville

Lunch options will be available for purchase for \$5.00 per day, per child.
